



2 Preparation Before Use

How to insert batteries

- Notes on using batteries

- 1. Do not use a battery that is leaking.
- 2. Use only Alkaline batteries (AAA batteries).
 - If other types of batteries (such as rechargeable batteries) etc. are used, the power is likely to be insufficient or battery life is shortened and cannot fully perform its potential.
- 3. Please insert the battery correctly according to the indication on the main unit and align ⊕ and ⊖.
- 4. Use batteries within the recommended usage period.
- 5. Please remove used up batteries immediately.
- 6. Dispose used batteries according to the local regulations of your area.



Before using

Turn the switch "ON" and wait for the color of the optimum temperature mark to change. Optimum

The color changes in approximately 1 to 2 minutes.

Please use at an ambient temperature between $15^{\circ}C\sim 35^{\circ}C$. If used at less than $15^{\circ}C$.

- It is difficult to curl.
- Battery life becomes shortened.
- The time to change the color of the optimum temperature mark becomes longer.



If the color does not change after 2 minutes or more, please check that the battery is inserted correctly.

If it is correctly inserted, the battery may be depleted, so please replace them.

• When the optimum temperature mark changes from purple to pink, the device can be used.

It may take time if the capacity of the battery is reduced or the ambient temperature is low.



Expressions	Meaning of Expressions





- Be sure to replace the cap after use. (It may cause injury or malfunction)
- If the device is not used for more than 1 month, remove the battery. (It may cause malfunction)
- Be careful not to put a comb into the eyes. (It may cause injury)

Please

- Use the device while checking with a mirror so as not to hurt your eyes.
- When the heater part touches the skin and feels hot, cool the skin with water.
- If mascara is attached to the heater part or comb, clean it before use.

Curl eyelashes

Raise the root with the main heater.

Place the eyelashes on the main heater part, rotate 90° outward to be parallel to the eyelid, and then hold for about 3 seconds.



2 Curl the tip of the eyelashes with the main heater.

Move the head part slowly to the tip of the eyelashes gently and form a curl, and then hold for about 3 seconds.

• Use the main heater to adjust the flow of the lower lashes.

Place the main heater vertically against the lower eyelashes, move slowly downward from the root and hold it at the tip of the eyelashes for 3 seconds.

Curl the upper and lower outer corner and inner corner of the eyes with the point heater.

Keep the point heater parallel to the eyelid and hold for about 3 seconds, then slowly move from the root to the tip of the eyelashes.




To prevent the comb from getting into the eyes, the comb is outside for the outer corner of the eyes and inside for the inner corner of the eyes.





Outer corner of eyes






After use

• Turn the switch "OFF" and after letting it cool, replace the cap.

Tips to achieve beautiful curl

- When curling the upper eyelashes, hold the mirror at a position below the eye line, and when curling the lower eyelashes, hold the mirror at a position above the eye line to make the eyelashes look better and make it easier to curl.
- Practice use without turning the switch "ON" until you get used it.

- Use the main heater for the center of the upper and lower eyelashes, and use the point heater for the inner and outer corners of the eyelashes.
- When the heater is applied to the root of eyelashes it makes it easier to form beautiful curl.



A Caution

• Do not press the heater part against the eyelid. (It may cause burns or accidents)

Better way of use

• Apply mascara after curling the eyelashes; apply the heater part after a little while to make a firm finish.



• If you feel abnormalities in the eyes and eyelids during use or after use, stop using the device and consult a specialist.

Separate eyelashes by removing extra mascara with a comb.

Move the comb slowly from the root of the eyelashes towards the tips of the eyelashes before the mascara dries.

🕂 Caution

- \cdot Be careful not to put the comb in the eyes. (It may cause injury)
- $\cdot\,$ Move slowly and carefully so that fibers and removed mascara do not get into eyes when combing.

(If combed with strong force, it may cause damage to eyelashes or cause injury)

6 Maintenance

A Caution

- · Be sure to turn the switch "OFF" while cleaning. (It may cause burns.)
- Do not wash with water. Also, do not soak in water or splash with water. (It may cause malfunction)


 Wipe off the dirt on the main unit with a cloth firmly squeezed with water. Do not use alcohol, benzine or thinner. (It may cause deformation or discoloration.)

• Remove the dirt from the head.

(The head part cannot be removed.)

• For grime such as mascara attached to the heater part and the comb, use the cleaning brush included in the product. Head part

• Wipe off the dirt on the main unit except for the head with a cloth containing diluted neutral detergent liquid.



7 Storage Method

Replace the cap and store it in a place with little humidity and dust.

\land Caution

- Do not leave in places subject to water or humidity. (It may cause malfunction.)
- Do not leave it in direct sunlight (such as inside a car in the summer), or near heating appliances. (It may cause deformation or discoloration.)

8 Troubleshooting (When problems arise)

Symptom	Where to check	How to fix
It will not get warm. (The color of the optimum temperature mark does not change.	Is the battery inserted incorrectly?	Please check⊕and⊝, then insert the battery again.
	Is the battery exhausted?	Please replace with a new alkaline battery.
It takes time to change the color of the optimum temperature mark. Or it takes time to get warm.	Ambient temperature is low.	When the ambient temperature is low, it takes time to warm up the heater, and the life of the battery becomes reduced. It is recommended to use at room temperature above 15°C.
	ls another type of battery that is not an alkaline battery	Please use alkaline batteries.
Abnormally hot.	used?	
It has become difficult to curl.	Is the heater part dirty with mascara etc.?	Please clean the heater part.
